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Park gets good eats

Office workers who eat lunch in Bryant Park will soon notice some changes there. Park management plans to add 600 chairs and tables to the grounds to accommodate an expected boom in diners when famed chef **Tom Colicchio's** 'wichcraft kiosks open in May.

The Bryant Park Restoration Project decided to install Mr. Colicchio's casual eateries in the park's four food kiosks, currently run by food service company CulinArt, to improve its bottom line.

"We'll be offering a competitive food option now," says **Dan Biederman**, executive director of the project, who notes that at present, most lunchers buy food outside the park and bring it in.

Each kiosk will offer different menu options, from soups and salads at one, to sandwiches or ice cream at another. They will be open year-round for the first time. **Jeffrey Zurofsky**, general manager of
